It has been minimally tested. If you make something from it please contact me at donnernblitzen@gmx.net and give me some feedback. Did it print the right size, how did it sew up, did it fit your Barbie?

Cut the triangle out of the pattern piece but not out of the fabric.

Just trace the two straight sides onto the fabric as stitching guidelines for the dart. I find that makes the easiest and most precise dart.

For the skirt just use a square gathered at the top. A good measurement for a skirt is 12" wide by 6" long, but the easiest way to decide how large it should be is just to scrunch the fabric in your hand around the doll body.
