



to confirm printing size, this line should be 4 inches long

Stitching allowances must be really close to the edge at the shoulders, or you can't get the bulk of the back to pull through the shoulder sections. Stitch as close to the edge as you can, then clip the curves before pulling the backs through. Taper back to regular 1/4 inch seams.

If you want any embroidery on any of these pieces remember to add it before cutting them out,

For the skirt, I used a piece of fabric 9 x 15 inches square.

Underskirt was the same size piece as the skirt, with lace sewn around the bottom and a foldover casing with elastic in it for the waist.

The apron was a piece 7.5 x 5 inches.
